## Summer Reading

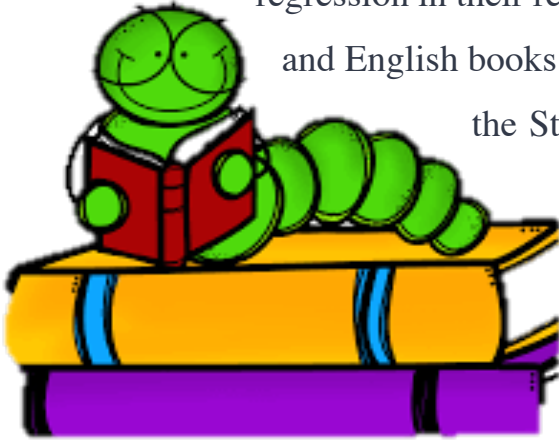
