

Reading numbers in French is sometimes tricky.



**Especially the groups of 60, 70, 80 and 90.**

**These cards and instructions should help you get the hang of it.**

**By putting first things first and working with these tools,  
you will be able to master these in no time!**

When you are practicing step 1 you can hole punch these cards  
and put them on a ring to keep them together.

**Chop these up, hole punch 'em  
and slide them on a ring. Practice as explained below.  
Take them off the ring as you master them.  
You can do it!**

<p>A trick for the 70s</p>	<p> soixante-DIX</p> <p>Hide the "flag" on the top of the number 70, you will see the number 10. This reminds you the number is soixante-DIX. This works for every 70 number. The dotted lines remind you to look for the teen number.</p>	<p>A trick for the 90s</p>	<p> quatre-vingt-DIX</p> <p>Hide the "balloon" at the top of the number nine, you will see the number 10. This reminds you the number is quatre-vingt-DIX. The dotted lines remind you to look for the teen number.</p>
<p>1</p>	<p>Choose a set of numbers to learn first. Lay them out, read them a few times, read them in order and out of order. Review them as often as you can.</p>	<p>4</p>	<p>You have mastered a set of numbers when you can name them all without hesitating and you get them right several times in a row. Don't move on to a new set until you have mastered one entire set.</p>
<p>2</p>	<p>Choose a colour and put the slips face down on the table or in a cup. Pull one out at a time and read the number word. Read all 10 numbers in random order in that colour. Review them as often as you can.</p>	<p>5</p>	<p>Practice the same way with each colour or number set. Practice in the car, at a restaurant, during free time in class and with a friend. Once you have mastered all of the numbers plan a reward for yourself!</p>
<p>3</p>	<p>Fold the number word side of the slip in half to the dotted line so the number word is hidden. Draw the slips and say the number without looking at the word. Unfold the paper to check if you got it right. If you get it right you keep it, if not put it back and keep going.</p>	<p>6</p>	<p>Here is a link that will help you practice, scroll down to the numbers you are working on.
